Winnsboro, Texas ~ Wood & Franklin Counties

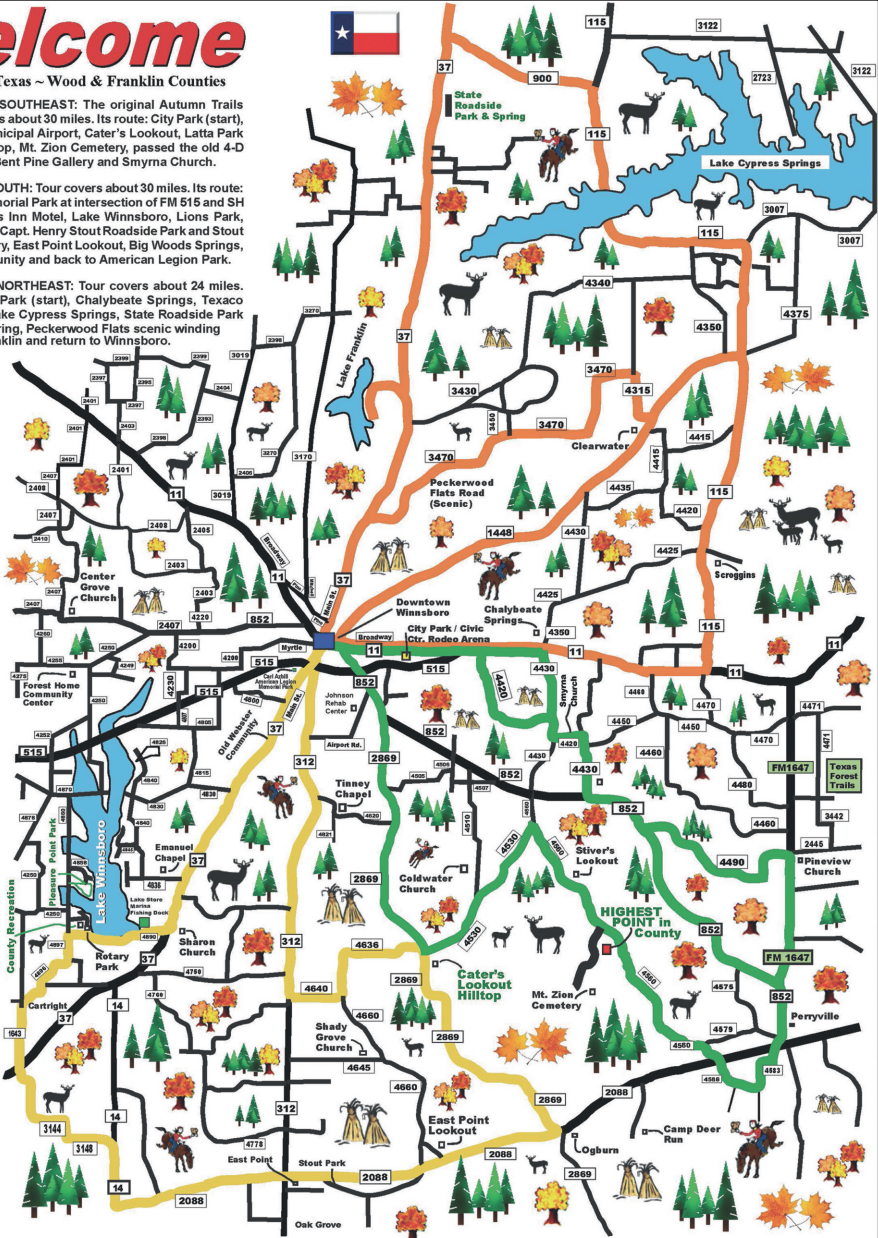
TOUR NO. 1 - SOUTH: The original Autumn Trails road tour covers about 30 miles. Its route: City Park (start), Winnsboro Municipal Airport, Cater's Lookout, Latta Park and Plaster Shop, Mt. Zion Cemetery, passed the old 4-D Guest Ranch, Bent Pine Gallery and Smyrna Church.

TOUR NO. 2 - SOUTH: Tour covers about 30 miles. Its route: Carl Azbell Memorial Park at intersection of FM 515 and SH 37 (start), Trails Inn Motel, Lake Winnsboro, Lions Park, Pleasure Point, Capt. Henry Stout Roadside Park and Stout Family Cemetery, East Point Lookout, Big Woods Springs, Ogburn Community and back to American Legion Park.

TOUR NO. 3 - NORTHEAST: Tour covers about 24 miles. Its route: City Park (start), Chalybeate Springs, Texaco Oil Refinery, Lake Cypress Springs, State Roadside Park with natural spring, Peckerwood Flats scenic winding road, Lake Franklin and return to Winnsboro.
